



# ILTA 2018 Annual Convention Questions and Answers

## Registration

Note: a registration summary for each registrant was emailed on September 14<sup>th</sup>. All registrants are asked to verify the accuracy of all information included in that summary. 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Q: I have an employee registered for the convention who cannot attend now. Can I **substitute that registration** for a different employee when we arrive in French Lick?

A: Yes. That change can be made at registration.

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Q: Can I **still register** someone from my office?

A: Yes; online registration will be open through September 19<sup>th</sup>. After that, onsite registration (for those who have not yet registered) will open at the convention hotel beginning Sunday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> and continue through the conclusion of the convention.

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## Icebreaker

Q: Can we **drive to the Icebreaker** Event (Sunday evening) even though buses will be available from the hotel?

A: Buses are the recommended mode of transportation to the Icebreaker event due to the remote location of the event venue, the Elk Ridge Ranch. From the French Lick Resort the Elk Ridge Ranch is approximately 20 minutes by car, over county roads (some of which are unpaved.) The address for the ranch is: 8785 Ridge Road, Shoals, Indiana. 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Q: What is the **schedule for the busses** going to/from the Icebreaker venue?

A: Motor coaches will be loading from the hotel beginning at 4:15 p.m. on Sunday. Departures will begin at 4:30 as each bus fills. The last bus is expected to leave the hotel at 4:45.

At the end of the Icebreaker, buses will begin returning to the hotel at 8:00 p.m. (or earlier if there is demand that fills each bus.) The plan is to have all guests returned to the hotel by 8:30 p.m.

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Q: Will I need to pick up my **registration packet/tickets** before going to the Icebreaker?

A: No. Name badges are not required at the Icebreaker event. However, to gain admittance to the Icebreaker, all attendees must be listed on the guest list when boarding the bus or arriving at the Icebreaker venue (if traveling by car.)

Convention registration will be open Noon – 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. During that time, those who have arrived at the hotel will be able to claim their registration credentials. Registration will re-open Monday at 7:45 a.m.

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Q: Can I still **register a guest** for the Icebreaker?

A: Yes; guests can still register onsite at the icebreaker venue. However, bus transportation is not guaranteed for onsite registrants and is only provided on a space-available basis. That means if there is room on the last bus leaving for the ranch, onsite registrants may board. If not, then onsite registrants will have to find their own transportation to the ranch.

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Q: What is the **recommended attire** for the Icebreaker?

A: Casual is the way to go. Jeans, shorts, comfortable shoes (for variable terrain.)  
Check the weather forecast as you pack!

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Q: What if it **rains**?

A: You're going to get wet! 😊 Seriously though, even if there is light to moderate rain, the event venue has enough indoor and tented space to accommodate our group. Plan accordingly.

## Miscellaneous

Q: What is the **suggested attire** for the convention?

A: Most attendees will wear business or business casual attire, with the following exceptions: For the Sunday evening Icebreaker, casual attire (including jeans and comfortable shoes) is suggested. The Icebreaker is primarily an outdoor event. For the President's Reception and Banquet (Monday evening) black-tie optional.

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Q: I have **meal restrictions**. Will there be menu options offered during the convention?

A: Most of the meals offered during the convention will be buffet-style which will include options for vegan, gluten-free, etc. If you have specific needs, please notify the ILTA office to report your restrictions no later than September 17th. 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Q: How many **CEs can I earn by attending the educational sessions** and how do I make sure I receive credit?

A: Continuing Education units will be awarded to all those who sign-in to the daily education breakout sessions and submit completed forms at the end of each day. The educational workshops are listed in the convention program. **CEs available each day and time are as follows:**

**Monday: 2 CEs** – 1:45 – 2:45; 3:15 – 4:15 p.m.

**Tuesday: 5 CEs** – 9:05 – 9:55 a.m.; 9:55 – 10:45 a.m.; 11:00 – 12:00; 12:55 – 1:45 p.m.; 2 – 3 p.m.

To receive credit for each day, you must attend at least one session in each available time slot for that day. Your form (available in the breakout room) must be stamped by the room attendant. You are responsible for submitting your own completed form to the convention registration office at the end of each day.

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Q: What about **CLEs**...will **continuing legal education** units be available for attending the education workshops?

A: Yes, the convention offers 7.5 hours of CLE credit (including 2 hours of ethics credit.)

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Q: I've heard there will be an **ITPAC auction** conducted during the convention. Who can participate and how does that work?

A: The ITPAC Auction will be in full force before and during the convention. All members will be able to start bidding when the auction opens September 17<sup>th</sup>. [Click here for all the details.](#)

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Q: Are there still **rooms available** at the French Lick Resort?

A: There are rooms available at the West Baden Resort (sister property of the French Lick Resort).
