

ILTA Education Committee Report for Annual Business Meeting

Our planned combined meeting with MBA and IAR that was scheduled for March 17, 2020 took place June 17, 2020 as an in-person meeting at the Ritz Charles where we had 95 attendees with 66 obtaining CE/CLE Credits. Most of our presenters were brought in virtually and with some quick actions from our member attendees, we overcame a handful of obstacles bringing this together. Topics presented were Statehouse Update for ILTA by Elizabeth Berg and Digital Closings and Remote Online Notary by various panel members.

On July 15, 2020 Tom Cronkright presented The New Technology Horizon virtually to our membership. There were 33 attendees, 15 obtained CE/CLE Credits.

The Education Committee coordinated speakers for our first Virtual Convention. We hope you enjoy the topics and the opportunity to earn CE/CLE Credits. Attendance for Convention has 116 of our membership and affiliates coming together.

The Education Committee is working with the Underwriter Section to add online classes to our current offerings and maybe retire or update any of our stale dated courses.

For the balance of 2020, the Education Committee will be determining if an in-person event will be possible-November/December and is also looking into bringing a few more virtual CE/CLE events to the membership.
